OFFERED FIRST SESSION ONLY

Sister Naasira Salahuddin accepted Islaam in the mid 1980s as a teen. She was born and raised in Brooklyn NY and now lives in Long Island, NY. She has 3 children and 3 grandchildren. She has been in healthcare for over 30 years and presently is a Nurse Administrator at a hospital in Long Island. She is a member of Masjid Allahu Akbar in Long Island, NY and is the Chairwoman of the Masjid's Women's Committee. She also is the founder and facilitator of the monthly, sisters-only, Reading for Jannah Book Club that was started in September of 2015.

Sabriah Bilal was born and raised in Philadelphia, the daughter of James and Antoinette Bilal. Mother to five children, she is the CEO of breebreespeaks, which is an organization whose mission is to empower, inspire, and aid in healing women through 1:1 coaching. She is a public speaker and author of Crooked Rib, Golden Soul. Sabriah has twenty years as an educator and believes in the education of youth. She has spent the last eighteen years as the Islamic Studies teacher for the Alimah Girl Scouts program based in Philadelphia, alongside her mother, Antoinette Bilal, who is the director.

Aishah Muhammad-Mumin became Muslim in 1972 in Philadelphia on Columbia Ave at the Masjid that was part of the Darul Islam movement. Right after the shahaadah, she started right in with learning about her new way of life and has studied Arabic, Qur'an and fiqh under various imams in person and online. They include Imam Javed Baiyat of the Laurel Masjid, and Tajweed under Muhammad ar'Raee of the Noorani Qaida publications earning a certificate. Alhamdulillah, she is a former member the Women's Committee of Masjid as Saffat (WCMAS) and the Gwynn Oak Community and has assisted in teaching and caring for children in the Baltimore and Laurel area. She has earned a design degree from the University of Delaware enhancing her sewing and computer skills. Aishah resides in Philadelphia where she still studies Qur'an now online with Bayyinah Institute and still assists in teaching and caring for children while she makes garments for the Muslims.

Maisha Muhammad is an 11-year member of WCMAS although she has been a member of the Masjid As-Saffat community over 40 years. The mother of 7 children, 23 grandchildren, and 4 bonus grandchildren, Sister Maisha is a former elementary/middle school teacher. She has taught at the Islamic Community School of Masjid As-Saffat for 9 years and in the Baltimore City Public School System for 18 years. Maisha is a member of Sharikat An Nisaa, a business of 5 Muslim women. Ms. Muhammad has studied under Imam Taif Abdullah, Imam of Masjid As-Saffat. She has also studied tajweed and tafseer under Sister Umm Zakiyyah at Masjid Al Ihsan. Maisha has lived in Baltimore all of her life.

Atiya Abdurrahman is a graduate of the Islamic Community School Baltimore MD. She has her undergraduate degree from the University Of Maryland, Eastern Shore, and her graduate degree from the University of Baltimore in Conflict Management Resolution. Atiya is a former member of the Junior Women's Committee, and has worked with WCMAS over the years as a quest presenter and in other capacities. Atiya is married and the mother of two children.

Taahirah Matin is a mother of 5, and grandmother of 3. She is a Baltimore native and spent 7 of her formative years in Saudi Arabia. She earned her Bachelor's of Science degree in Social Work from Morgan State University. She is currently a teacher at Islamic Community School, where she is also an alumna.



Having studied Aqeedah, Tafsir and Seerah under the auspices of Imam Taif Abdullah for more than 40 years, she joined the Iqaamatiddeen Organization several years ago (Iqaamatiddeen means the establishment of the DEEN OF ALLAH). Aisha is also a teacher and educator, holding both a BA and Masters in Education. For almost 20 years, she held the title of headmistress of an International Girls School in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia. Arabic, Quran and Islamic Studies were major components of the curriculum of the school. Presently, Aisha is an entrepreneur, and Alhamdulillah has written her first book!

Rehana b. Yahya has been with the Women's Committee of Masjid As-Saffat since its inception and studies under Imam Taif Abdullah, Imam of Masjid As-Saffat in Baltimore, Maryland. Ibnul Qayyim (RA) said,

"A girl died of the plague and her father saw her in his dream. He said, 'my daughter, tell me about the hereafter. So she said, 'We've approached a serious matter. We used to know but we didn't act. I swear by Allah, to add one tasbeehah (saying Subhan Allah) or a single Rak'ah to my book of deeds is more beloved to me than the whole world and everything in it.'

This girl said words of great importance. 'We used to know but we didn't act', but many of us don't understand what she means.

We used to know, that if we say Subhan Allah wa bi Hamdihi 100 times our sins are forgiven even if they're like the foam of the sea (yet days and nights pass and we don't say it)

We used to know that two rak'ahs of Duha prayer is the equivalent of giving 360 charities (yet day after day pass and we don't pray it)

We used to know that a house in the middle of Januah is guaranteed for one who abandons lying even while joking (yet every second sentence we utter is a lie)

We used to know that fasting a day voluntarily for the sake of Allah puts a distance between our face and the fire the size of seven trenches and Allah distances our face from the fire the distance travelled in 70 years, (and we haven't fasted single day this week)

We used to know that whoever visits a sick person is followed by 70,000 angels seeking Allah's forgiveness on his behalf (but we haven't visited a sick person this week)

We used to know that whoever prayed a funeral prayer and followed it till it was buried has two Qiraats of reward and a Qiraat is like the mountain of Uhud (yet weeks pass and we haven't been to the graveyard.)

We used to know that whoever builds a mosque even if it's like a bird's nest Allah builds a house for them in paradise (yet we haven't contributed to the building of a Masjid, even with 10 dinars)

We used to know that the one who supports the widow and her children is like the fighter in the path of Allah and the one who fasts all day and prays all night without sleeping. (Yet we haven't contributed to sponsoring a widow and her children)

We used to know that whoever reads a single letter from the Quran has a good deed and every deed is multiplied by 10. Yet we haven't made a point to read it every day.
